



Small Blue Action Group

The Small Blue Project was launched in March 2009. Already, it has had several successes with habitats being restored and the Small Blue and other key butterflies and moths returning to sites that had lost them. Despite this early success it is important to plan for long term future to enable this whole landscape to continue to improve for wildlife and in particular, the Small Blue.

To plan for the future it is intended to establish a Small Blue Action Group involving all key partners and interested parties. The group will keep in contact mainly by regular e-mails, but will meet formally every six months to collate progress reports and to ratify further aims and actions. These meetings will last no longer than an hour and where appropriate will be supported by site visits to see projects and progress on the ground. All interested parties will receive updates by quarterly newsletter.

Aims of Group

- To provide advice and guidance to landowners or managers
- To share how successes have been achieved and other lessons learned
- To share the results of research and experiments
- To develop new projects to establish or restore wildlife habitats
